

Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District

The Western Riverside County Water/Wastewater MSR incorrectly reported that the primary shareholders of the Meeks and Daley Mutual Water Company were the Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District (EVMWD) and the County of Riverside. The primary shareholders are actually EVMWD and the **City** of Riverside. EVMWD maintains and operates the Meeks and Daley system. The District also has certain water rights associated with its ownership of the Water Company.

EVMWD has notified LAFCO that it has formed a Joint Powers Authority (JPA) with Meeks and Daley Water Company. The JPA is known as the Water Employee Services Authority (WESA). WESA will assume all of EVMWD's management functions including employment of the District's current employees. WESA would be responsible for all compensation and benefits to its employees. Pursuant to operating agreements entered into between the parties, WESA will provide services to both Meeks and Daley MWC and EVMWD. EVMWD will provide both office space and equipment to WESA.

LAFCO has no jurisdiction over the JPA or the operating agreements. EVMWD has provided this update for information purposes only. It is included here as a correction, clarification and update to information presented in the MSR.
