SUBJECT: PROPOSALS RECEIVED AND/OR LAFCO INITIATED (GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 56751 AND 56857)

Following are new proposals received by LAFCO since the last Commission meeting. Each summary below contains a brief description of the location, the acreage and an approximate date range when it is anticipated that the item will be heard by the Commission. The anticipated dates are tentative and may change as proposals are processed. Also included for the Commissioners' information are vicinity maps showing the location of this proposals.

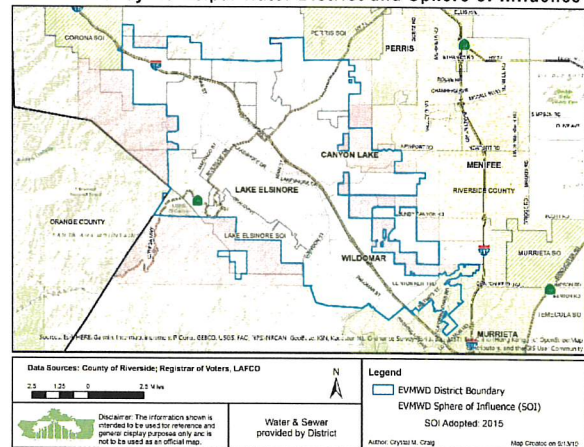
The Countywide Water and Wastewater Municipal Service Review (MSR) was approved May 23, 2019 that covered 12 cities and 32 special districts for a total of 44 public agencies that provides water and wastewater services to residents within Riverside County. Western Municipal Water District, Eastern Municipal Water District and Rancho California Water Districts will be reviewed after the Focused Municipal Service Review is completed.

For ease of dividing the Sphere of Influence (SOI) Reviews, the agencies are divided into three sub regions: 1) Western County, 2) Pass/Mountain Area, and 3) Coachella Valley/Eastern County. For those 12 Cities that provide water and wastewater they will not be reviewed under this SOI Review. Those cities SOIs will be reviewed with the full City comprehensive MSR and SOI reviews.

i. LAFCO 2020-01-1 & 5 - WESTERN COUNTY REGION WATER AND WASTEWATER AGENCIES - SPHERE OF INFLUENCE REVIEW AND POTENTIAL AMENDMENTS: EL SINORE VALLEY MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT.

Generally located within Western County. Primarily, it serves the cities of Lake Elsinore, Canyon Lake, Wildomar, the California Oaks Development within the city of Murrieta, and a small area in Orange County. EVMWD serves the unincorporated communities of Lakeland Village, Meadowbrook, Rancho Capistrano/El Cariso Village, Horsethief Canyon, and Temescal Canyon.

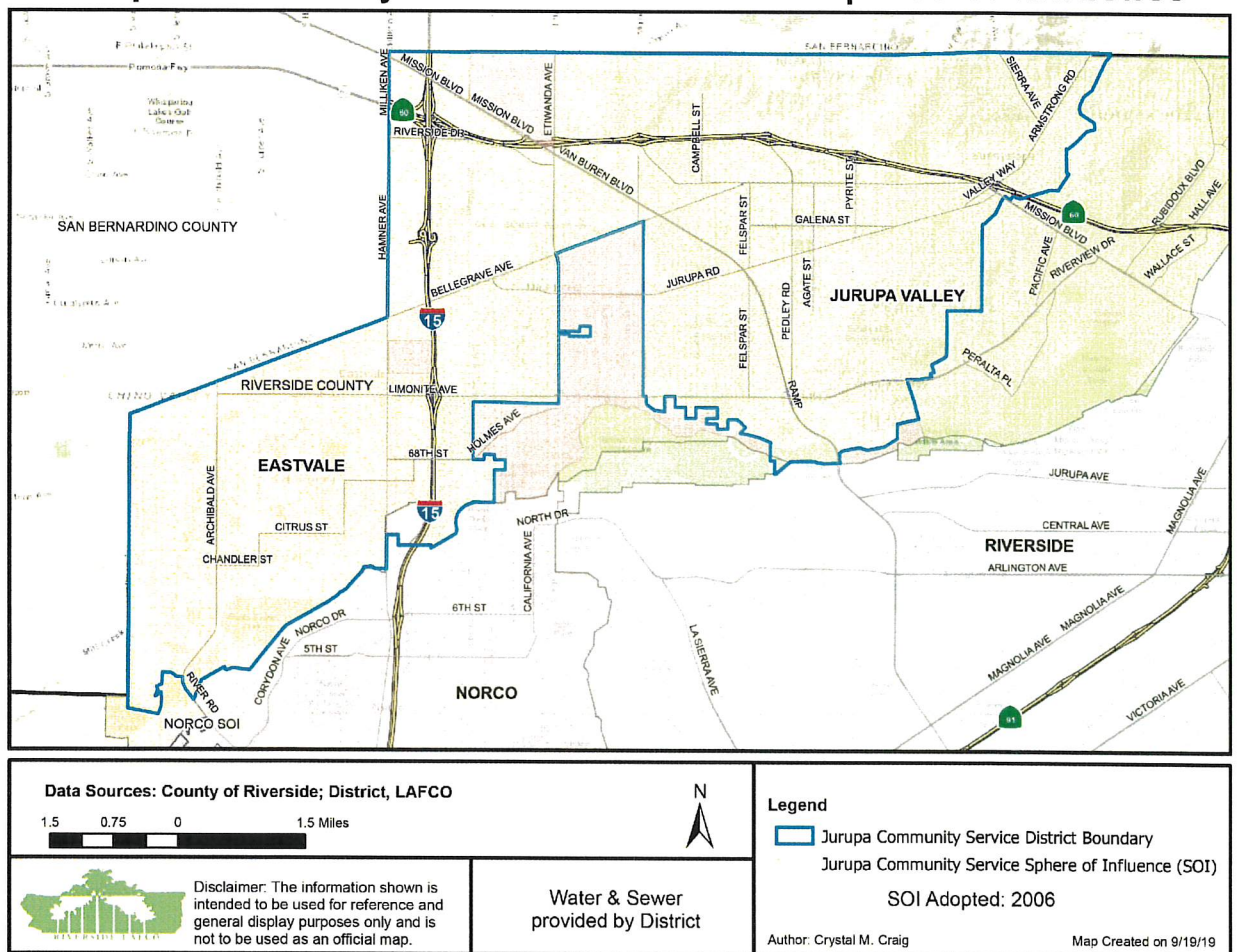

Jurupa Community Services District and Sphere of Influence



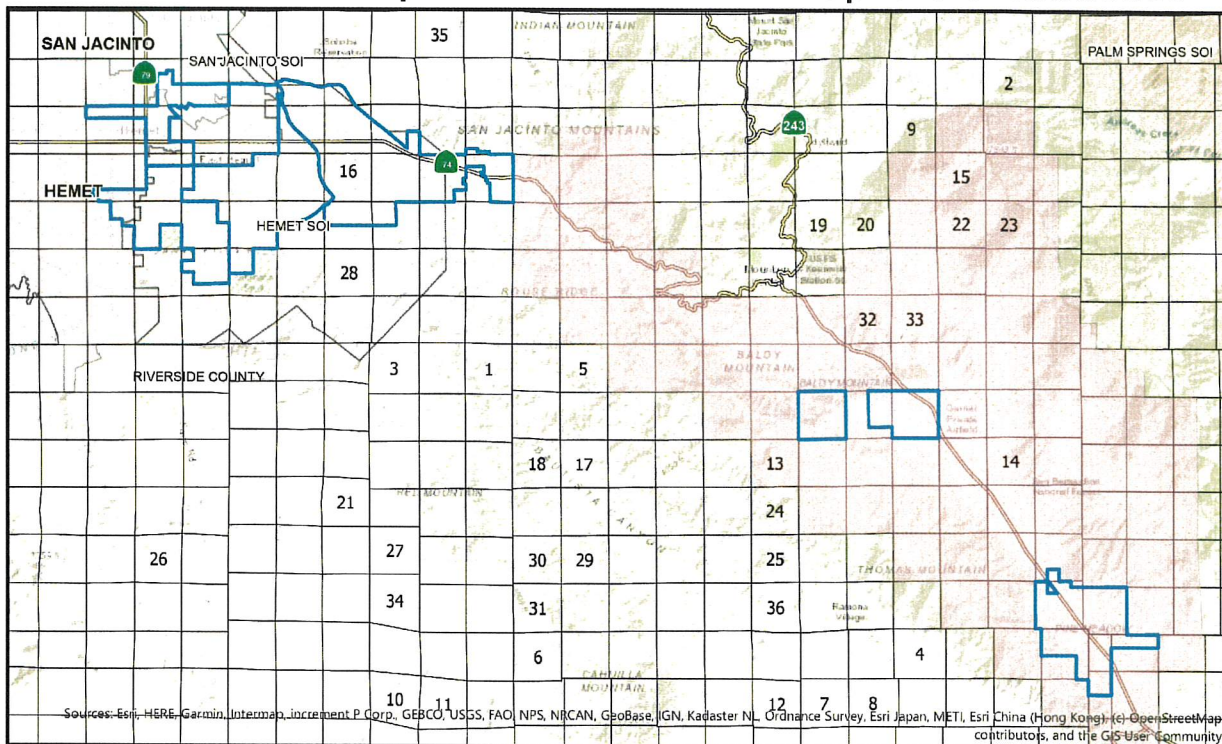

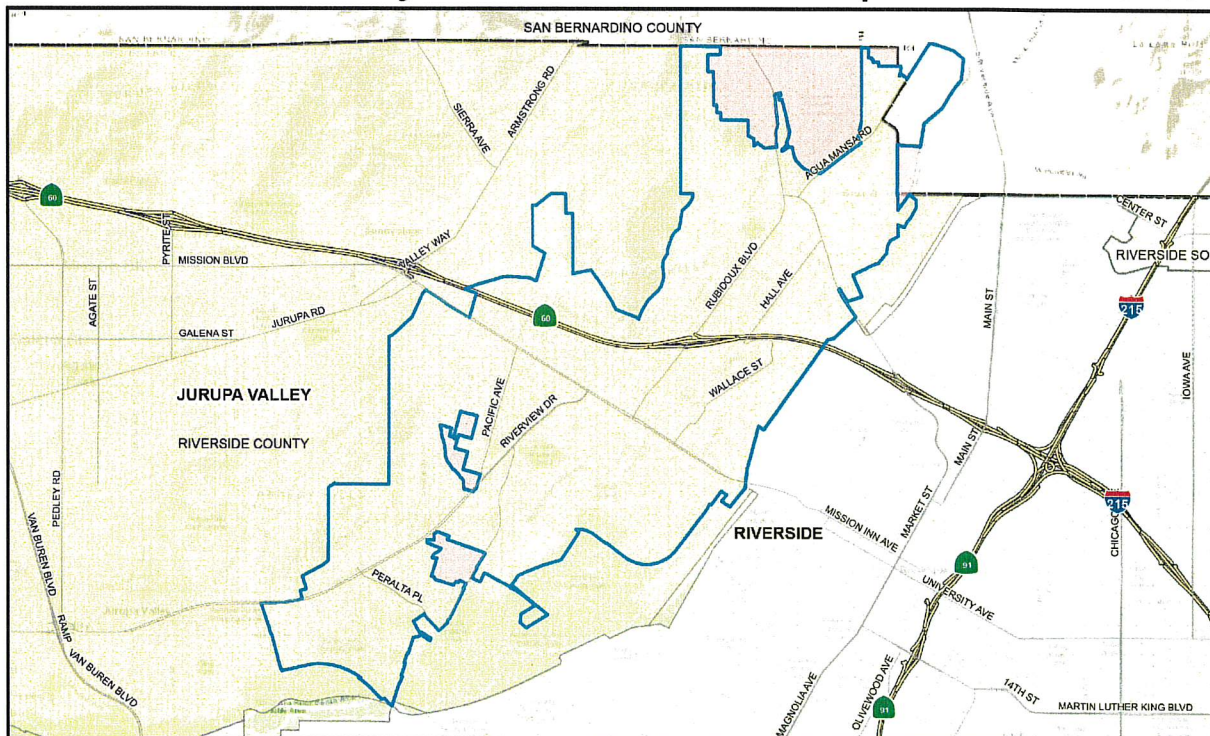

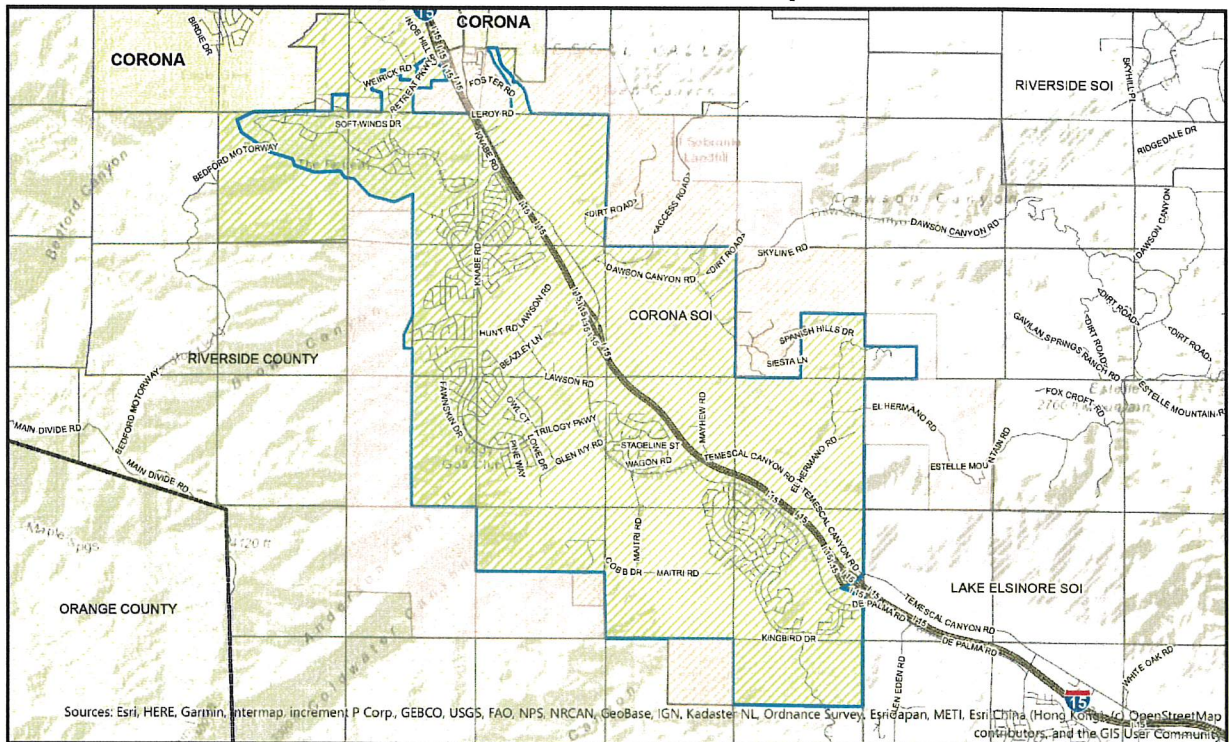

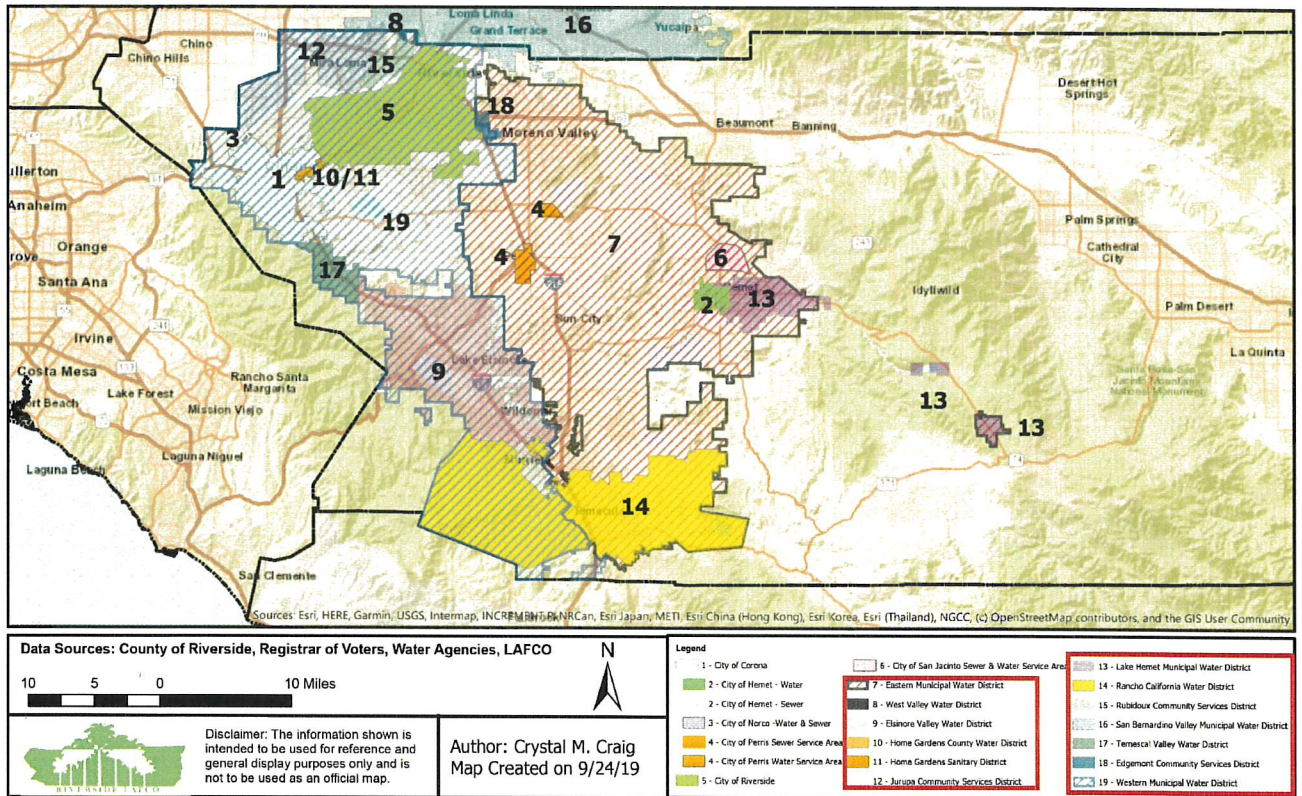

WESTERN REGION WATER & WASTEWATER PROVIDERS



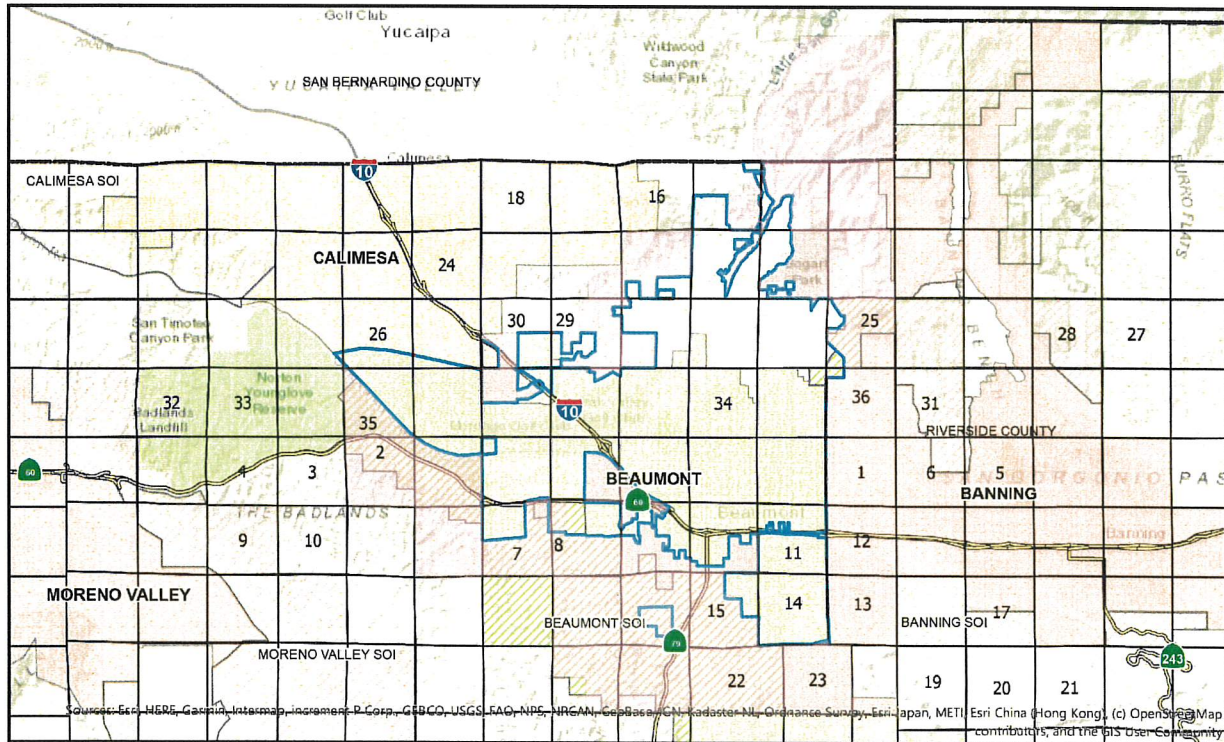

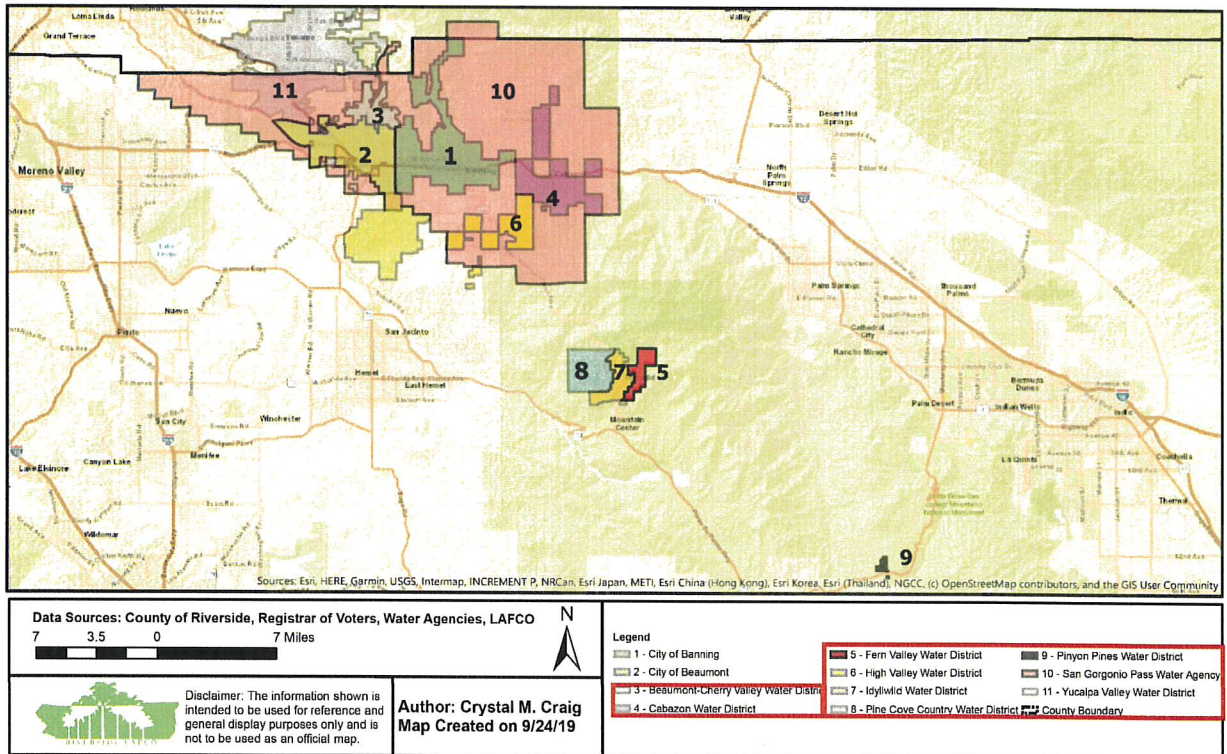

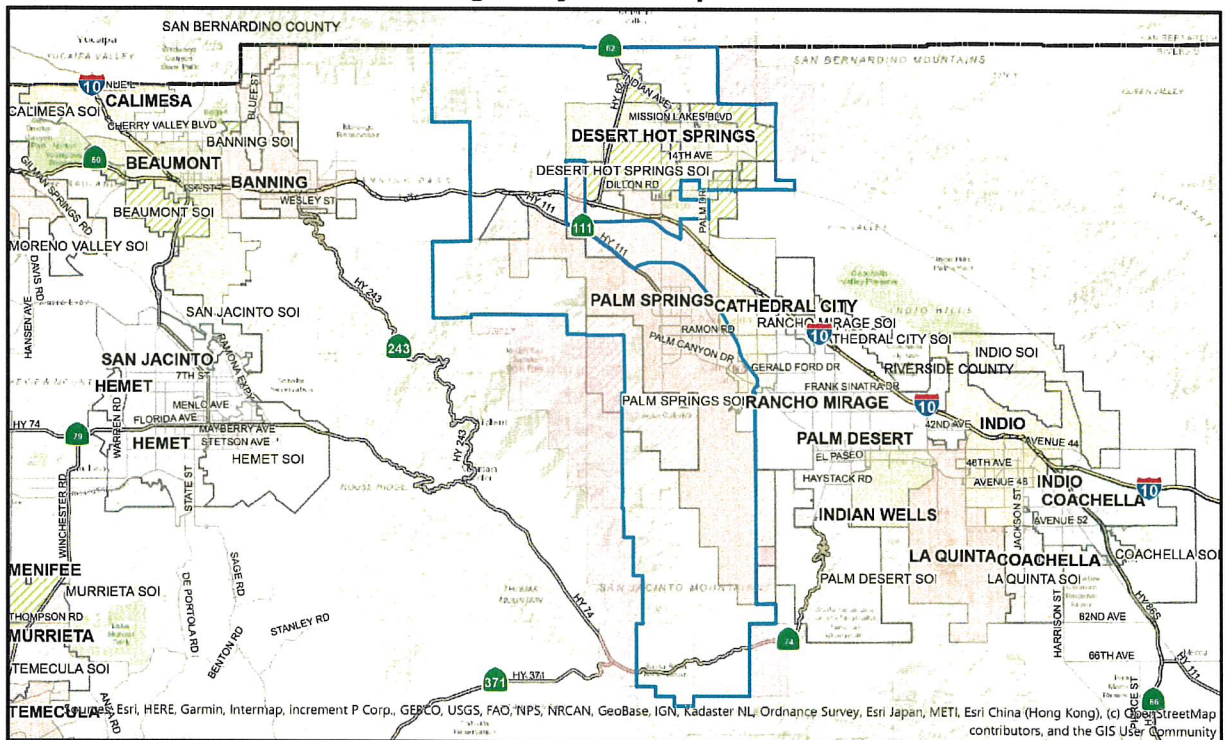
