NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the **Riverside Local Agency Formation Commission on Thursday, June 25, 2020 at 9:30 a.m.** on the proposals listed below. The meeting will be held in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, County Administrative Center, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California. This meeting is also being held via teleconference due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Consistent with Governor Newsom's Executive Order N-29-20, if members of the public would like to participate in the meeting, they may do so via teleconference. Details of electronic participation will be available when the agenda is posted, at least 72 hours in advance of the Commission meeting. There will be limited space for public to attend the hearing in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room. For purposes of limiting the risk of COVID-19 transmission, members of the public are highly encouraged to participate via teleconference. Comments submitted before the start of the Commission meeting will be part of the public record and distributed to the Commissioners for their consideration.

- 1. LAFCO 2020-07-5-Pass/Mountain Area County Regions Water and Wastewater Agencies-Sphere of Influence Review and Potential Amendments: Beaumont-Cherry Valley Water District and a finding of exemption pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act:** The boundaries can be generally described as being south of the community of Oak Glen in San Bernardino County, east of the west section line of Section 34 Township 2 South Range 2 West, west of Highland Springs Blvd., and north of Gilman Springs Rd. The area includes the City of Beaumont and servicing the unincorporated area of Cherry Valley.
- 2. LAFCO 2020-13-5-Dissolution of Valley Health System and a finding of exemption pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act:** Generally located south of Interstate 10, west of the community of Idyllwild, north of the City of Murrieta and east of the City of Lake Elsinore.
