NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the **Riverside Local Agency Formation Commission on Thursday, May 25, 2023, 9:00 a.m.** on the proposals listed below. This meeting will be held in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, County Administrative Center, 1st Floor, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California. If members of the public would like to participate in the meeting, they may do so in-person or via teleconference. Details of electronic participation will be available when the agenda is posted, at least 72 hours in advance of the Commission meeting.

LAFCO 2023-01-1,2,3,4,5-Countywide Municipal Service Review and Sphere of Influence Reviews and Potential Updates-Independent Recreation & Park Districts: Beaumont-Cherry Valley Recreation and Park District, Desert Recreation District, Jurupa Area Recreation and Park District, and Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District and a finding of exemption pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act:**

Beaumont-Cherry Valley RPD: (Supervisorial District 5) Generally bounded on the north by the City of Calimesa and the Riverside/San Bernardino County line, on the west by unincorporated Riverside County, on the east by the City of Banning, and on the south by the city of Beaumont, and encompasses the City of Beaumont. Beaumont-Cherry Valley RPD is 64.4 square miles.

Desert RD:(Supervisorial District 4) Generally bounded on the north by the Riverside/San Bernardino County line, on the west by the City of Cathedral City, on the east by unincorporated Riverside County, on the south by the Riverside/Imperial County Line, and encompasses the Cities of Palm Desert, Indian Wells, La Quinta, Indio, Coachella and a portion of the City of Rancho Mirage. Desert RD is 1,861.5 square miles.


Jurupa Area RPD:(Supervisorial Districts 1 & 2) Generally bounded on the north by the Riverside/San Bernardino County line, on the west by Hamner Ave in the City of Eastvale, on the east and south by the Santa Ana River/City of Riverside, and encompasses the City of Jurupa Valley and a portion of the City of Eastvale. Jurupa Area RPD is 46.4 square miles.

Valley Wide RPD:(Supervisorial Districts 3 & 5) Generally bounded on the north by the City of Beaumont and Riverside County unincorporated territory, on the west by the Cities

of Menifee and Temecula and Riverside County unincorporated territory, on the east by Riverside County unincorporated territory, on the south by the Riverside/San Diego County Line and encompasses the Cities of Hemet and San Jacinto, and a portion of the City of Menifee. Valley Wide RPD is 530 square miles.
