NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing will be held before the **Riverside Local Agency Formation Commission on Thursday, May 28, 2020 at 9:30 a.m. on the proposals listed below.** The meeting will be held in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, County Administrative Center, 1st Floor, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California. This meeting is also being held via teleconference due to the COVID-19 pandemic. There will be limited space for public to attend the hearing in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room. 1. **LAFCO 2020-02-2-Western County Region Water and Wastewater Agencies-Sphere of Influence Review and Potential Amendments: Jurupa Community Services District and a finding of exemption pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act:** Generally located within northwest Riverside County and is bounded by San Bernardino County to the north, north of the Cities of Norco and Riverside, the Santa Ana River to the south. The District serves the Cities of Eastvale and a large portion of Jurupa Valley.
2. **LAFCO 2020-04-2-Western County Region Water and Wastewater Agencies-Sphere of Influence Review and Potential Amendments: Rubidoux Community Services District and a finding of exemption pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act:** Generally located within northwest Riverside County and is bounded by San Bernardino County to the north, Jurupa Mountains and Pedley Hills in the northwest, unincorporated areas of Riverside County to the west, the Santa Ana River to the south, and the City of Riverside to the east. The District serves a portion of the City of Jurupa Valley.
3. **Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2020/21.**
